The permit may be revoked for disciplinary reasons and/or non payment of fees owed to the City in accordance with "City of League City code of ordinances Sec. 8 1/4-23"

The League City Police and Fire Departments have policies and procedures which are not specified in the ordinance.

Permits are valid one (1) year from issue date and must be renewed prior to expiration to insure police response.

## **CITY ADOPTS ALARM ORDINANCE**

The City of League City has adopted an alarm ordinance in an effort to reduce the number of false alarms received by the police and fire departments. A substantial number of those false alarms can be attributed to faulty equipment or persons unfamiliar with the operation of alarm systems. Police and firefighters occupied with false alarms may not be immediately available when an actual emergency arises.

Effective March 18, 1996, all private and commercial properties protected by alarm systems must apply for an alarm permit. Separate permits are required for each burglar, panic/hold-up or fire alarm system with a total permit fee of \$10.00 per address. Permits are not required for stand alone smoke alarms.

The ordinance requires that a permit holder having more than five (5) false alarms per year be assessed a \$50.00 response fee for each additional false alarm call. Persons not having the required permit(s) may be charged with a Class "C" Misdemeanor.

A permit application has been included in this publication for your convenience. Questions regarding burglar, hold-up or panic alarms should be directed to the police department at 332-2566. Information concerning fire alarms can be obtained by contacting the fire marshal's office at 334-7870. A copy of the ordinance may be picked up at city hall Monday through Thursday from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm and Friday 8:00 am to Noon.

### **FEE SCHEDULE**

#### **BURGLAR, FIRE, AND HOLD-UP/PANIC ALARMS MUST HAVE SEPARATE PERMITS.**

Contact your alarm company if you are not sure which permits your alarms system requires.

#### **RESIDENTIAL & NON-RESIDENTIAL ALARM PERMITS**

\$10.00 PER ADDRESS (Annual renewal required)

Fee includes one (1) or more permits for burglar, hold-up/panic or fire alarms at a single address.

Five (5) false alarm calls are allowed without charge per permit per year. Thereafter false calls are chargeable at \$50.00 each. Permit subject to revocation for non payment of fees or as otherwise prescribed by ordinance.

In addition to false call fees, violations of the alarm ordinance are subject to criminal prosecution as a Class C misdemeanor.

PERMITS ARE VIALID ONE (1) YEAR FROM ISSUE DATE. PERMITS MUST BE RENEWED PRIOR TO EXPIRATION TO INSURE POLICE AND/OR FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE.
